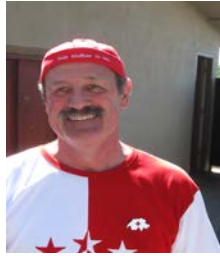


Presidents Message

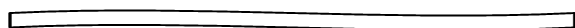

Traditions on the UNESCO List

Reprinted from the Swiss Review December 2014 newsletter

Eight Swiss traditions should be included in the UNESCO List of Intangible Cultural Heritage. This decision was reached by the Federal Council in October. 167 traditions, ranging from the Aargau Bachfischet procession to bilingualism in Biel, are deemed intangible cultural heritage in Switzerland. The following should be included in the UNESCO list, according to the Federal Council: the approach to dealing with the avalanche risk, watchmaking, Swiss graphic design and typography, the Swiss alpine season, yodelling and the Basel carnival. www.lebendige-traditionen.ch

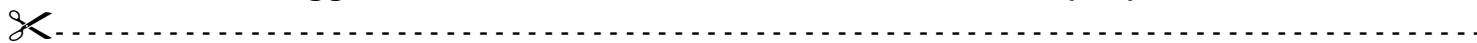
